Here are some examples of the effects that you can use

1. Text Formatting

1. Bold: **abc**

2. Underline: abc

3. Italics: *abc*

4. Strikethrough: ~~abc~~

5. Superscript: abc^{abc}

6. Subscript: abc_{abc}

7. Colour: **abc**
